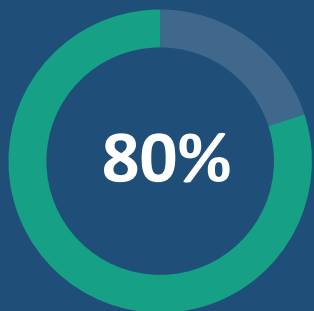


Performance Management Maturity Shortens Development Timelines

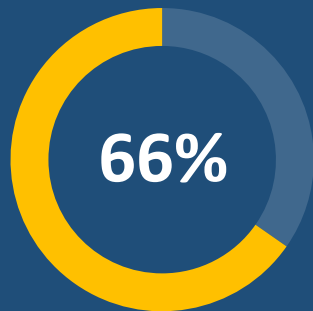


Percentage of internally developed applications that are deployed on or ahead of schedule

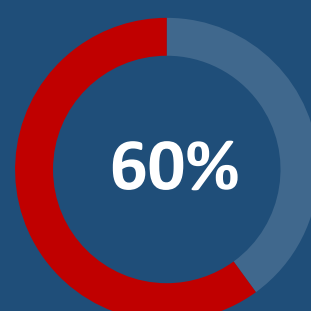

ESG recently conducted a quantitative research study to assess companies' performance management maturity.

Organizations were segmented into three categories of maturity – **Expert**, **Aspiring**, and **Nascent** – based on their performance management tools and processes.

Expert organizations complete development projects on or ahead of schedule much more often than other firms. The ability and propensity of these organizations to monitor performance in test and dev environments may help them identify issues sooner and resolve them earlier in the development lifecycle.
