Securing and Accelerating Encrypted Traffic

Encryption has become the default for virtually every enterprise application. While this is essential for protecting data, it also creates a challenge for network optimization. Traditional acceleration technologies typically cannot optimize encrypted traffic because they cannot safely inspect the data stream.

The Challenge

Organizations today face a difficult balancing act. Business success increasingly depends on moving data quickly between users, applications, data centers, cloud environments, and AI platforms. At the same time, that data must be protected against growing cyber threats, regulatory requirements, and emerging risks such as quantum-enabled attacks. As a result, enterprises can no longer treat performance and security as separate priorities.

Paradoxically, since most enterprise traffic is now encrypted, this limits the effectiveness of traditional optimization techniques because acceleration solutions cannot optimize traffic they cannot safely inspect.

Consequently, organizations often experience higher bandwidth consumption, slower application performance, increased cloud costs, and reduced productivity despite investments in network optimization.

Meanwhile, AI initiatives, cloud migrations, SaaS adoption, and distributed workforces are driving unprecedented volumes of data across wide area networks. Delays in data movement directly impact application responsiveness, user experience, and business outcomes. Yet security teams must ensure data remains protected in transit, during processing, and against future threats.

Organizations need a new approach that combines acceleration and security, a platform capable of optimizing encrypted traffic, protecting sensitive data with modern security controls, and preparing for emerging threats without compromising application performance. What's more, the solution needs to provide demonstrable proof of the value it delivers to the business.

How Keystone Server Works

With the explosive growth of encrypted traffic many businesses find the network has once again become a critical bottleneck to productivity, innovation and growth without sacrificing security or governance. For many organizations, encrypted traffic represents the largest remaining acceleration opportunity.

RiOS 10 addresses this challenge through integration with Riverbed Keystone Server, a centralized TLS and signing service designed specifically to help organizations optimize encrypted traffic without compromising security controls. Keystone and RiOS 10 make it possible to unlock that opportunity while maintaining the governance, visibility and security controls that modern enterprises require.

Rather than distributing cryptographic keys across the network, Keystone centralizes trust management and keeps private keys securely contained within the service. Security teams manage Keystone server, and networking teams manage SteelHeads. SteelHeads directly use the Keystone server securely by their configuration, so security teams retain complete control over which traffic can be accelerated with Keystone services.

This approach mirrors the same trusted security models already used by firewalls, secure web gateways and application delivery controllers. By allowing encrypted traffic to be safely decrypted, optimized and then re-encrypted, organizations can dramatically expand the benefits from SteelHead acceleration. The result is improved application responsiveness, reduced network utilization, better end-user experiences and greater value from existing network infrastructure.

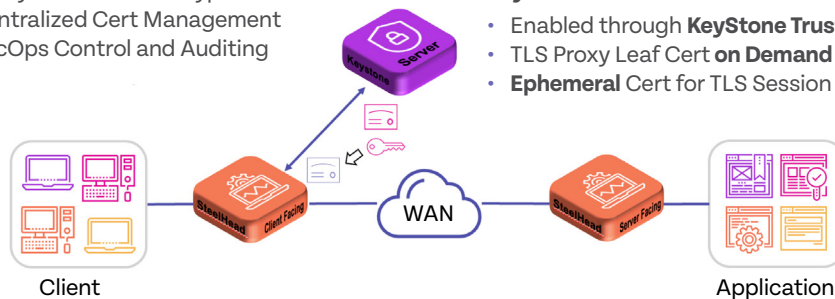

Post-Quantum Cryptography

One of the more significant future cyberthreats is [quantum computing](#). While large-scale quantum computers may still be years away, cybersecurity experts increasingly warn about “harvest now, decrypt later” attacks, where encrypted information is intercepted today and stored until future quantum systems are capable of breaking traditional encryption methods.

RiOS 10 incorporates [post-quantum cryptographic protections](#) that help organizations begin preparing for this inevitable transition while protecting sensitive business communications against emerging threats.

For organizations in government, financial services, healthcare and other regulated industries, this capability represents a critical step toward future-proofing the security of their infrastructure.

Confidential Computing

RiOS 10 also introduces advanced protections for data while it is being processed. Through confidential computing technologies, workloads remain protected not only when stored or transmitted but also while actively being used. This is particularly important in public cloud and multi-tenant environments, where organizations must ensure that sensitive information remains isolated and protected throughout their lifecycle. Additional platform security enhancements include **Total Memory Encryption (TME)**, which protects data moving between the CPU and system memory, **Secure Boot** capabilities that verify the integrity of software and firmware during startup and **Trusted Platform Modules (TPM)** that provide a hardware-based root of trust and secure cryptographic key management. Together, these capabilities significantly strengthen the overall security profile of SteelHead while helping customers meet increasingly stringent compliance and governance requirements.
